

- **PAYMENT**

The \$100 deposit to secure the date is non-refundable. Full payment is due 2 weeks before the scheduled program. An invoice will be sent to the above email unless otherwise discussed with the Overnight Coordinator at Iridgway@bpzoo.org.

- **RELEASE FORMS**

A link to our online After Hours Release Form will be sent to the above email. This form must be completed for each participant attending the program. All forms are due 2 weeks before the scheduled program. If a participant does not complete the form in the allotted time, they will not be allowed to attend the After Hours Program.

- **WEATHER**

After Hours Programs are held rain or shine. Each participant should wear outerwear and shoes suitable for an outdoor walk around the zoo grounds in all weather conditions. If the program must be cancelled due to inclement weather, you will be given the option to reschedule your After Hours Program or receive a refund.

- **CHAPERONE POLICY**

One chaperone over the age of 18 is required for every five participants under the age of 18. Chaperones are counted in the participant total which must not exceed 50 people.

While we hope that chaperones have just as much fun as the children, we ask that they be active in supervision and discipline (if necessary) so that staff can concentrate on education and activities.

- **RESTRICTED ITEMS**

We do not allow children to bring cell phones, iPads, gaming devices, or any other electronic items to the Program.

Pets of any kind, smoking, vaping, and alcoholic beverages are not permitted.

- **FOOD & BEVERAGE**

CRITTER CAMP-IN: We will provide a cheese pizza dinner, water, lemonade, and an ice cream dessert.

Popcorn will be provided during the feature film shown at the end of the evening. In the morning, breakfast will be cereal, fruit, milk, orange juice, and water. Coffee will be available for adults. We ask that you do not bring food to your Program. If you need to bring your own food due to medical, cultural, or religious reasons, please discuss this before your Camp-In with the Overnight Coordinator at Iridgway@bpzoo.org. We are unable to accommodate food allergies at this time.

TWILIGHT TOUR: We will provide a cheese pizza dinner, water, lemonade, and an ice cream dessert. We ask that you do not bring food to your Program. If you need to bring your own food due to medical, cultural, or religious reasons, please discuss this before your Camp-In with the Overnight Coordinator. We are unable to accommodate food allergies at this time.

- (CRITTER CAMP-IN ONLY) **OVERNIGHT STAY**

Critter Camp-In participants will sleep in our climate controlled classrooms on carpeted floors. Outlets are available around the classroom. A staff member will sleep across the hall and a night watchman will be on zoo grounds at all times during your visit.

Please be aware that the zoo does not have shower facilities.
